Discussed about internal assessment pattern for 30 marks and activities such as study tour, NGO visit, social work, research oriented work and conducted other value addition course. Dr. Kendre Sir, Prof. Rokade Sir and Deshpande Madam put three criteria of the internal marking that class room active participation and attendance, project work and class room test as well as they told that the department should to conduct certificate course on gender empowerment, gender sensitization, Shrangare Sir stated about Food and fruit processing skill based course and everyone had approved that course for the students. They hope it will be very useful for students.

Further Discussion had conducted about semester end external examination. Exam will be taken for 70 marks. The two questions with internal choice will ask per unit for 15 marks. Out of two the students have attempt any one question per section A or B. Total four questions have to attempt out of 8 questions for 60 marks and each question carries 15 marks. Remaining 10 marks will for short notes. Two short notes out of four students have to attempt for 10 marks and each short note for 05 marks.

Prepared the exam board is for upcoming examinations by the discussion among the Kendre sir, Rokade sir and Shrangare sir. Shrangare sir requested to Kendre sir and Rokade sir to suggest the expert names for exam board then they accepted the request suggest the names are Dr. Shashi Mishra, Dr. Anagaha Tendlokar and Prof. Arolkar. Dr. Kendre sir told that department should to take care and finalised examiners and moderators.

Academic year planning for next year 2019-20 is sanctioned as it is by the present members. As well as they told department should to conducted value added and skill based certificate courses which is on gender empowerment and gender sensitization. After these all discussion that meeting had completed by the vote of thanks. Short notes. Students have to attempt any 2 short notes out of 4. Means (02 x 05 marks = 10 marks). This is semester end examination question paper pattern.
